

Lord's Love Church COVID Response & Reopening Details

Updated: August 27, 2021

This week the BC Government has announced updated preventative measures in response to the ongoing pandemic and delayed moving into Step 4 of BC's Restart Plan.

As the government has announced that [religious gatherings are exempt from the mask mandate and vaccine passport](#), we welcome all to return to in-person worship services. In an effort to create a safe and comfortable space for everyone attending, we will be putting in place the following guidelines for all gatherings within the church building:

- **Masks will be required within the church building. Children ages 3 and under are exempt. Face shields are not considered as acceptable alternatives to face masks.**
- **We will continue to practice social distancing before, during, and after service. Pews will be clearly marked to indicate areas for seating.**
- **Temperature check and hand sanitation will be required upon entry to the church. We ask everyone to practice proper hand hygiene with frequent handwashing and sanitising.**
- **Sharing of food within the church is not permitted.**
